    - Should we specify a time of year for the inspection based on parcel use?
    - Hood Canal Action Area? Should this include Kitsap?
    - Other?
  - Amount?
    - The initial proposal was “up to \$250” for septic tank inspection (and pumping if necessary), and/or tank risers. This would cover an estimated 40 properties.
    - It has been proposed that we increase this to \$400 (estimated 25 properties).

- Should we include filter screens? Some industry people have strong opinions on filter screens –whether or not to use and what kind to use.
