Executive Summary

In 2016 the first credit release for the program was accomplished at the Irene Pond Mitigation site. In April 2016 a credit release for Objective 1A-Site Protection of the mitigation plan was documented as complete and the co-chairs for the program issued a credit release letter. These earned credits are shown in item 2 below within the WRIA 15 Freshwater Service Area Credit Ledger. This credit release fulfills the program's mitigation obligation for WRIA 15 Freshwater Service Area credits sold to date and resulted in a positive 'no net loss balance' for all three wetland credit functional categories.

In 2016 numerous marine mitigation project properties were investigated and pursued; however no properties were acquired in 2016. A Purchase and Sale Agreement was presented to the seller of a large shoreline parcel in Dabob Bay, unfortunately the seller rejected the offer and would not entertain additional offers and ultimately removed the property from listing services. Potential opportunities for marine mitigation will continued to be pursued in 2017.

The Myrvang Wetland project intended to include the acquisition of a conservation easement on a portion of an adjoining parcel. After a long period of discussion with the adjoining landowner they ultimately decided that a conservation easement on their property at this time would not be feasible. As a result of this decision the funds in the Land Fee account that had been held for this easement were applied to the acquisition costs of the Myrvang property. The Myrvang Wetland mitigation plan preparation was delayed while the pursuit of the conservation easement on the adjoining parcel was conducted. The plan will be completed in early 2017 and submitted to the Corps for the public review and comment process.

One spending agreements was executed on November 11, 2016 for the remaining 25% balance of the Program Administration funds from deposits made in 2013/2014.

One credit sale was completed in 2016. On December 19, 2016 marine credits were sold to Mr. Ralph Brindley for NMFS WCR-2016-5272 mitigation requirements and the project was permitted under Corps permit #NWS-2015-1042. The impact project was a repair and replacement of a failed bulkhead within the south marine Assessment and Mitigation Unit, near Belfair, WA.

c. Date the funds were received from the permittee – The Statement of Sale between Mr. Ralph Brindley and HCCC was executed on December 19, 2016.

3. A description of HCCC ILF Program expenditures from the account:

Land acquisition – The WRIA 15 Land Fee account was used to fund the Myrvang Wetland property acquisition. The Myrvang Wetland, a 22.97 acre property in Poulsbo, WA at Iverson and Stottlemeyer roads was acquired on November 18, 2015 for use as a mitigation receiving site for the Navy EHW2 WRIA 15 credit sale. This acquisition was funded through the Mitigation Project Account and the Land Fee funds were intended to be used to acquire an additional 4 to 5 acre conservation easement on an adjoining parcel. After a long period of discussion with the adjoining landowner they ultimately decided that a conservation easement on their property would not be feasible at this time. As a result of this decision the funds in the Land Fee account that had been held for this easement were applied to the acquisition costs of the Myrvang property. The Mitigation Project Account for this project was reimbursed the Land Fee amount of \$9,199.20.

- a. Planning WRIA 15 Mitigation Project Account and Program Administration funds were spent to negotiate with the landowner adjoin the Myrvang Wetland property and to develop the Myrvang Wetland Mitigation Plan which will be completed in early 2017. Review of wetland areas, mapping of weed species and development of concepts for site enhancement actions were all conducted in 2016. Mitigation Project Account funds were used to complete the boundary survey and for legal counsel review of the draft conservation easement for the adjoining property.
 - b. Construction No construction actions were executed in 2016.
- c. Monitoring The Great Peninsula Conservancy completed annual site encroachment surveys at the Irene Pond property and the Myrvang Wetland property. An invoice for this activity has not been received to date.

d. Maintenance – Site maintenance at the Irene Pond property was conducted in 2016 by HCCC staff and a Washington Conservation Crew (WCC) sponsored by the Hood Canal Salmon Enhancement Group. Maintenance actions included garbage removal, weed control, plant maintenance and installation of replacement plants. These activities were funded through the WRIA 15 Mitigation Project Account. The WCC crew worked to remove blackberry, English Ivy, holly, and yellow archangel. Approximately 1,100 pounds of English Ivy was hauled to the dump by HCCC staff in 2016. Approximately \$5,941 was spent on site maintenance in 2016.

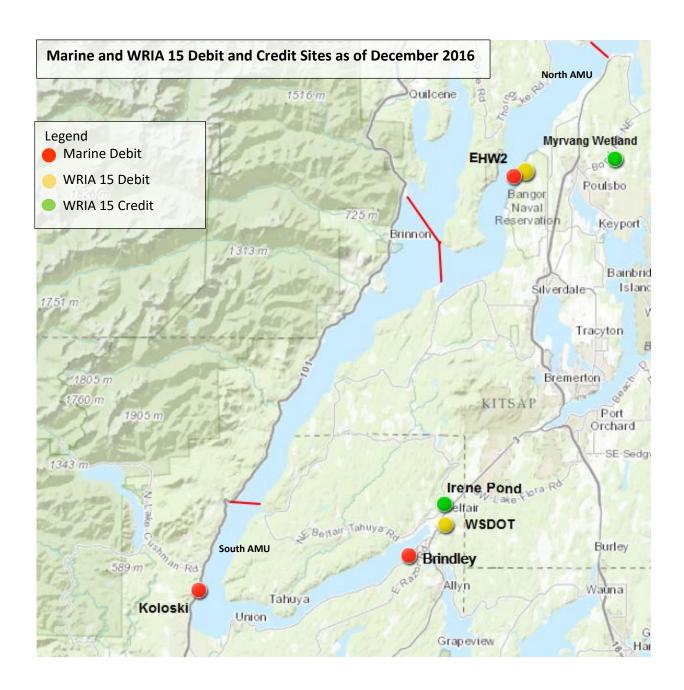
