Hood Canal Summer Chum recovery supported by Seattle Times editorial board: Success

South Hood Canal dissolved oxygen reaching dangerously low levels. Nannoos' ORCA buoys at <u>Twanoh</u> and <u>Hoodsport</u> are showing hypoxic conditions near surface waters, earlier than normal for this time of year. South winds could bring fish kill events. Local Integrating Organization (LIO) On-site Septic Action Plans in development, with \$183,000 newly awarded from EPA and the Puget Sound Partnership for implementation of a priority action in each LIO. Hood Canal's LIO OSS Action Plan will be finalized in Sep.
